2026 Lenten Regulations for the Diocese of Santa Rosa

"The Lenten Season has a double character, namely, to prepare both catechumens and faithful to celebrate the paschal mystery. The catechumens, both with the Rite of Election and Scrutinies, and by catechesis, are prepared for the celebration of the sacraments of Christian initiation; the **faithful**, ever more attentive to the Word of God and prayer, prepare themselves by penance for the renewal of their baptismal promises" (The Order of Prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours and the Celebration of the Eucharist).

The current discipline is as follows:

- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of **fast and abstinence**, that is, limited to a single, full meal and abstinence from meat.
- The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- The law of **fasting** permits only one full meal a day, but it does allow the taking of some food in the morning and a second light meal at noon or in the evening, as you prefer. People who have completed their eighteenth year to the beginning of their sixtieth (60) year are obligated to fast.
- The law of **abstinence** from meat applies to all persons who have completed their fourteenth year of age. However, it is highly recommended that children from ages seven to fourteen years also follow the law of **abstinence**.
- All Catholics are encouraged to receive Holy Eucharist frequently during Lent and to receive the Sacrament of Penance so that all may be prepared to celebrate more fully the paschal mystery. Those who have received their first Holy Communion are to receive Holy Communion during the Easter season.
- The determination of these days of obligatory penance, as listed above, should not be understood as limiting the occasions for Christian penance. This penance is to help us see and shorten the distance between our present lives and the life God wants for each of us. "Penance should not be only internal and individual but external and social" (*Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy*, 110).
- **Marriages** may be celebrated with Mass and the nuptial blessing should always be given. It is, however, contrary to the spirit of penance during Lent to plan an elaborate wedding with lavish decorations.

Confirmation at the Easter Vigil: Canon Law grants to pastors and parochial vicars the faculty to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation - within their proper parish - to any adult or child over the age of seven years on the occasion of his or her baptism or reception into full communion with the Church.



Regulaciones para la Cuaresma del 2026 en la Diócesis de Santa Rosa

«El tiempo de Cuaresma tiene un doble carácter: preparar tanto a los catecúmenos como a los fieles para la celebración del misterio pascual. Los catecúmenos, mediante el Rito de la Elección y los Escrutinios, y a través de la catequesis, se preparan para la celebración de los sacramentos de la iniciación cristiana; los fieles, cada vez más atentos a la Palabra de Dios y a la oración, se preparan mediante la penitencia para la renovación de sus promesas bautismales» (Orden de la Oración en la Liturgia de las Horas y la Celebración de la Eucaristía).

La disciplina actual es la siguiente:

- El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de **ayuno** y **abstinencia**, es decir, se permite una sola comida completa y se debe abstenerse de comer carne.
- Los demás viernes de Cuaresma son días de **abstinencia** de carne.
- La ley del ayuno permite solo una comida completa al día, pero también permite ingerir algo de alimento por la mañana y una segunda comida ligera al mediodía o por la noche, según se prefiera. Las personas que han cumplido los dieciocho años hasta el comienzo de los sesenta años están obligadas a ayunar.
- La ley de la **abstinencia** de carne se aplica a todas las personas que han cumplido los catorce años de edad. Sin embargo, se recomienda encarecidamente que los niños de siete a catorce años también observen la ley de la **abstinencia**.
- Se anima a todos los católicos a recibir la Sagrada Eucaristía con frecuencia durante la Cuaresma y a recibir el Sacramento de la Penitencia para que todos estén preparados para celebrar plenamente el misterio pascual. Quienes hayan recibido su Primera Comunión deben comulgar durante el tiempo pascual.
- La determinación de estos días de penitencia obligatoria, tal como se enumeran anteriormente, no debe interpretarse como una limitación de las ocasiones para la penitencia cristiana. Esta penitencia nos ayuda a reconocer y acortar la distancia entre nuestra vida actual y la vida que Dios desea para cada uno de nosotros. «La penitencia no debe ser solo interna e individual, sino también externa y social» (Constitución sobre la Sagrada Liturgia, 110).
- Los **matrimonios** pueden celebrarse con Misa y siempre debe impartirse la bendición nupcial. Sin embargo, es contrario al espíritu de penitencia de la Cuaresma planificar una boda ostentosa con decoraciones lujosas.

Confirmación en la Vigilia Pascual: El Derecho Canónico concede a los párrocos y vicarios parroquiales la facultad de administrar el Sacramento de la Confirmación, dentro de su propia parroquia, a cualquier adulto o niño mayor de siete años con motivo de su bautismo o de su admisión a la plena comunión con la Iglesia.

Fr. Raul Lemus invites you on a pilgrimage through some of the holy sites of France October 19-29, 2026. The pilgrimage sites will be two nights in Lourdes (where the Blessed Mother appeared to St. Bernadette Soubirous in 1858), one night in Avignon (where the popes lived from 1309-1377), one night in Paray Le Monial (where St. Margaret Mary Alacoque received the promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus), one night in Nevers (the resting place of St. Bernadette Soubirous), four nights in Paris (our Mass in Paris will be at the Miraculous Medal Shrine of St. Catherine Laboure), and Lisieux (a day trip in our tour bus while in Paris to visit the resting place of St. Therese of Lisieux). The trip concludes with a free day in Paris to shop and enjoy sites on your own. The cost is \$5,499, which includes airfare, hotel accommodation, tour bus, tour guides, breakfast and all dinners, except for one dinner in Paris. Los lugares de peregrinación serán 2 noches en Lourdes (donde la Santísima Virgen le apareció a Santa Bernadette Soubirous en 1858), una noche en Aviñón (donde vivieron los papas entre 1309 y 1377), una noche en Paray Le Monial (donde Santa Margarita María Alacoque recibió las promesas del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús), una noche en Nevers (el lugar de descanso de Santa Bernadette Soubirous), 4 noches en París (nuestra misa en París será en el Santuario de la Medalla Milagrosa de Santa Catalina Laboure), y Lisieux (un excursión de día en nuestro autobús turístico mientras estamos en París para visitar el lugar de descanso de Santa Teresa de Lisieux). El viaje concluye con un día libre en París para comprar y disfrutar de sitios por tu cuenta.
